- Part renewal of ceiling in ladies showers following repointing (Paul Adam)
- Servicing of ventilation/extract fans on courts hadn't been done for a number of years (Tony Swift and Jason)

#### Membership

No in house club championships were held hoping to resume in 2022.

#### Juniors.

Since the return of squash in May junior coaching was able to resume. We have several new players attending Saturday mornings following successful mini squash sessions held at a couple of local primary schools. Junior team squash starts again in October and we have entered 3 teams.

We held a junior Bronze open in conjunction with the adult PSA event in July and a junior closed in September that was well attended.

# Appendix 2 – Treasurer's Report

It has been a difficult year with covid and lock down issues preventing and restricting club opening

Where possible we have reduced attendant standing costs, reduced maintenance costs and

negotiated reductions in charges, for example council rates

But costs for the likes of utilities and rent are charged regardless

The times when we have opened after lock down periods and restrictions imposed have been increased costs for both cleaning and cleaning materials

Bar sales do show a loss, due to the wastage of stock over several lock downs

The value of 6months members subscriptions held from 2020 has been allocated across both 2020/21 and 2021/22 in recognition of membership discount currently being offered

As a result of all above, income for the period has been severely affected

however, grants from the likes of MBC and Sport England have provided over £25,000 to lessen the impact

Resulting in net assets increasing by £1,908 to £31,391
